### **Audition Instructions**

#### Prepare an audition audio file to submit with the audition form.

If you are mailing us a CD, please label the CD and sleeve clearly with your name. On the box or CD sleeve, also list the name of the composition you are performing. If you are not interested in being a soloist (vocal or instrumental), you may omit step #4 below.


The audition recording must include the following:

- 1. Please say your name [and the title of your song if you are auditioning for a major solo] before beginning.
- 2. The first stanza of "America" ("My Country 'tis of Thee"), melody, sung without accompaniment, beginning on the pitch listed for your preferred voice part.

(Make sure you sing the melody for the entire stanza, ending with "...let freedom ring!")

**Soprano I** (D5) Start on D, an octave and a note above middle C Soprano II (B4) Start on B, above middle C Alto I (G4) Start on G, above middle C Alto II (C4) Start on middle C Tenor I (C4) Start on middle C Tenor II (Ab3) Start on Ab, below middle C **Baritone** (F3) Start on F, below middle C Bass (C3) Start on C, one octave below middle C (If your range permits, also demonstrate contrabass.) Contrabass (C2) Start on C, two octaves below middle C (If you do this, also demonstrate bass range.)

3. A vocalise which demonstrates the extremes of your range. See samples below:



Note: PLEASE don't vocalize on every half step of your entire range! Do three or four at the top and the same at the bottom!

4. (Optional) If you wish to be considered for a major solo: Sing/play a composition of your own choosing, accompanied or a cappella. Instrumental introduction should be very brief (1-2 measures.)
